Residents Day at Academy 2010 San Francisco

Are you an OD in a residency program? Do you have a grand rounds case that you would like to share with the audience at the American Academy of Optometry Annual Meeting, Academy 2010 San Francisco?

Current residents are invited to submit grand rounds cases for presentation as both papers and posters by September 1, 2010.

Application is made by submitting a case report outline as detailed below to HelenV@aaoptom.org. The reviewers will determine whether the presentation style will be a poster or a paper. Upon acceptance, paper presenters will need to submit a Powerpoint® presentation.

Case Report Format

Each case report is required to begin with an abstract, limited to 35 **words** (present tense), describing the case. Then follow with the details as listed below.

- I. Case History
 - Patient demographics
 - Chief complaint
 - Ocular, medical history
 - Medications
 - Other salient information
- II. Pertinent findings
 - Clinical
 - Physical
 - Laboratory studies
 - Radiology studies
 - Others
- III. Differential diagnosis
 - Primary/leading
 - Others
- IV. Diagnosis and discussion
 - Elaborate on the condition
 - Expound on unique features
- V. Treatment, management
 - Treatment and response to treatment
 - Refer to research where appropriate
 - Bibliography, literature review encouraged
- VI. Conclusion
 - Clinical pearls, take away points if indicated

PowerPoint® is required for paper presentations. Presentations will be 15 minutes. Presenters must adhere to HIPAA rules regarding patient identification. Posters must fit on poster boards that are 4 feet high and 6 feet wide. If the submission is accepted for presentation as a paper, the deadline for final Powerpoint® submission will be October 12.
