## letter from the president

In November I visited the University of Houston. The major reason was to meet with three of this year's Ezell Fellows and to recognize them in front of their faculty and peers. Meeting with these three young scientists energized me. It was exciting to hear about their research and their aspirations. Discussing their career plans was an opportunity to share my own experiences as a PhD student and, several years later, a post-doc looking for a position in research and education. Their achievements also motivated one of their faculty, Dr. Ruth Manny (herself a Former Ezell Fellow), to join the Presidents Circle.

Any of you who met this year's Ezell Fellows at the AOF Luncheon in San Diego or through other interactions will have been impressed by their credentials and drive. They remind us of why the AOF's mission is so important and what a great investment it can be for the entire profession. In 2005 it was our pleasure to make the first award from the George Mertz Fund to Dr. Loretta Szczotka in the form of an Ezell Fellowship. Industry, professional, and personal friends of George have contributed or pledged over \$200,000 to establish this fund. George would have been touched by this generosity and proud of our awardee. Loretta also joined the Presidents Circle in 2005.



Overall, it was a great year for the Foundation in which we received a number of significant donations. Bausch & Lomb recognized Drs. Richard Hill and Donald Korb as their 2005 Visionary Awardees. Dick and Don each pledged their \$20,000 award to the AOF, respectively completing the Fry Award and Mertz funds. Thank you both and thank you Bausch & Lomb for this great program that supports philanthropic organizations and recognizes excellence at the same time.

Last fall, the Foundation gratefully received a very generous bequest of over \$32,000 from the estate of Helen Langhoff. Ms. Langhoff's association with optometry is unclear, but this fabulous gift is probably the result of past professional services or friendship from a supporter of the AOF. 

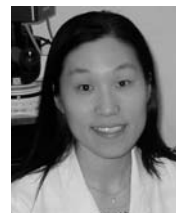

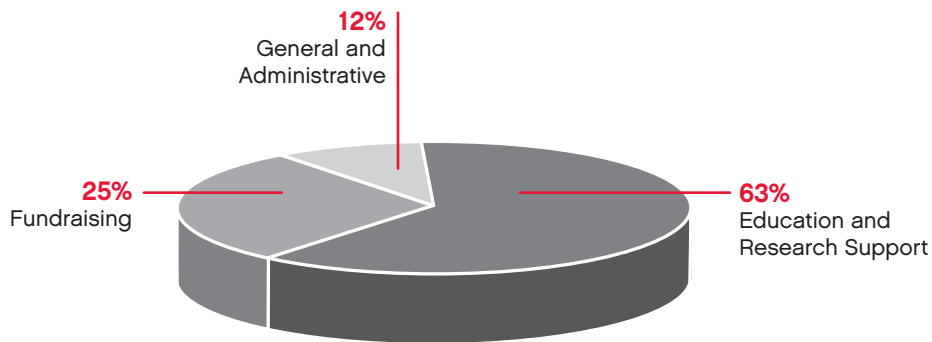
